For most new websites we recommend our current simplified pricing of \$55/month for unlimited pages, users and storage.

Current Client Legacy Pricing Options for 2015

Unfortunately, at this time our hosting company does not allow us to automatically move websites that are on the legacy tiered pricing to the new simplified pricing plan. Any *new* website will be eligible for the simplified pricing plan. If you are a current customer and would like to move your current website from legacy monthly pricing to the simplified pricing plan, below are a couple of options for you to consider:

1. **You can stay at your current legacy pricing rate, which includes priority support.** For those on our *Roasting* (\$69) or *Blazing* (\$99) plans we will provide a prorated credit to your account for the difference between legacy pricing and the new simplified pricing (starting from June 2014 until December 2016). This credit is only eligible for website design and branding services, not our monthly fee.
2. **We can estimate the cost for our team to manually move your website to the new simplified pricing plan.** Generally, this works out to \$10 per page. In this scenario after we've moved your website to the new account you would then start paying the simplified monthly amount. The turnaround time on this option varies depending on the size of your website. Our team would be moving your website to the new account element by element, as we are unable to automatically transfer.
